

Top 10 Things to do with Flashcards

(Online fun, too!)

Goal: Fact Fluency

1. Have someone hold up the cards for you. Say the problem and the answer.
2. Play "Musical Flashcards." Place the cards on the floor. Play music. When the music stops, pick up the card closest to your feet and say the problem and answer.
3. Play "Hide a Fact." Have someone hide the flashcards in one room. Have them count-1, 2, 3, Go! Find a flashcard. Say the problem and answer. Try to find as many as you can in 2 minutes!
4. Sort your flashcards by answer. Ideas-more than 10, less than 10, even or odd.
5. Google "Math Magician" and play flashcard games online. Make it as tough as you like!
6. Pop Quiz! You say the problem; your parents repeat the problem and say the answer. Be sure to check their answers!
7. "Just Do It!" Read the problem and solution and do an activity that many times. Ex. $3+2=5$. Do five jumping jacks!
8. Play "Math Artist!" After solving a problem, do a quick draw of that many items OR add that many things to a picture you already drew!
9. Play "Word It!" Solve the problem and write a word with that many letters. Ex. $9-3=6$. Write Connor (6 letters)
10. Play "Tic Tac Toe!" Place the cards in three rows of three. Choose one card. Solve the problem. If you are correct, turn it over to the back. If you are wrong, leave it face up. Try to get three in a row!

**Bonus: After solving a problem, say the "flip-flop" fact ($3+1=4/1+3=4$) OR a related fact ($4-1=3/3+1=4$). That makes a fact family! ☺
